2. Discussion

John Kolb says PG&E under grounding boundaries are probably going to be the auto dismantler to the west on 89, across the Wolfe Creek bridge to the south on Main St., and to Bush St. to the north on Main.

Quincy has automatic watering in the tree wells. John will provide drawings of what they did. The county pays for the water. The trees used have root systems that grow more down than out to help avoid sidewalk buckling. Some trees used there are maples, locust, and sycamore.

Streetlights in Quincy are generally 12 at a 800-900' spacing.

Parking on Main St. - Josh and Dawnette are going to measure the width of Main to see if sidewalks can be widened while keeping parking as is on both sides of the street. Need 16-18' for parking space on each side and 32' road between.

Talked about bus stop locations, the corner in front of Feather River Properties, and different possibilities for paths. Lanis will research bus stop locations and who might fund bus stop shelters.
